




1 Read SHE is SHE. BUY THE HARDCOVER





- One of the characters in SHE is SHE is wearing a shirt that says, "Don't Erase Women". We live in a culture that tells us that our "gender is fluid." It says that if we feel that we are
 - not biologically the gender that we're created with, we can somehow change that. We can't. Our gender/sex are determined at conception. It's in our DNA and results in thousands of biological differences between females



and males. When we deny God-given design, the identity of Christ in each of us is brought into question.
